All persons entering the ground must comply with the following **Ground Regulations**.

VISITING THE BROOK STAINES & LAMMAS (MIDDX)

Staines Lammas Football Club was founded in 1926 and took its name from the park land adjacent to the River Thames in Staines, Middlesex (now known as Staines-upon-Thames).

In the mid-1980s the Club moved to the Laleham Recreation Ground and changed its affiliation to the Woking League (which subsequently became the Guildford & Woking Alliance League) under the jurisdiction of the Surrey County Football Association.

The Club then progressed to the Surrey Senior League, which later amalgamated into the Combined Counties League. Unable to be promoted to the Premier Division due to ground grading requirements, the Club, at the start of the 2009–10 season, entered into a ground share with Ashford Town (Middx). Although they returned briefly to Laleham, they are now ground sharing with Abbey Rangers at Addlestone Moor.



FOLLOW THE TRACTOR Staines & Lammas (Mx) 27th November

Directions - From the ground goal along Kingshill Avenue. Turn left on to Lansbury Drive and go through two roundabouts.

Turn right on to Uxbridge Road/A4020 and turn left on to West Drayton Road/B465. At roundabout, take the 1st exit on to Stockley Road/A408 and do the same at next roundabout to stay on A408/Stockley Road. Stay on Stockley Road.

At Heathrow Interchange, take the 3rd exit on to the M25W/M4W slip road. Merge on to M4. At Junction 4B, take the M25 (S) exit to M3/M23/M20/Heathrow Airport/Gatwick Airport.

Merge on to the M25. At Junction 11 exit towards Chertsey/A320/Woking.

Keep left to continue towards St Peter's Way A320.

Merge on to St Peter's Way/A320.

At Addlestone Moor Roundabout take the 2nd exit on to Addlestone Moor.

Turn right to stay on Addlestone Moor then turn left for destination.
