All persons entering the ground must comply with the following **Ground Regulations**.

Failure to do so may result in being asked to leave the ground and a ban from attending any future events in the ground.

7. The use of horns, hooters or any musical instrument that will affect the enjoyment of others.
8. No animals permitted in the ground with the exception of guide dogs.
9. The throwing of any missile, object or projectile.

We have an interesting festive period with an away game at struggling FC Deportivo Galicia on 21st December.

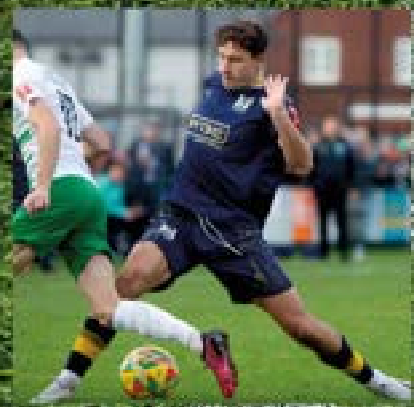
The main game is on 28th December when we are at home to our good friends Chalfont St Peter and we are hoping for a big gate at Farm Park.
